ORDER ON AFFIDAVIT OF POVERTY

The *pro se* (Petitioner) / (Respondent) [*strike through appropriate*] has filed an *Affidavit of Poverty* with the Clerk of Court. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 9-15-2(d), the Court has reviewed the *Affidavit* and other proposed pleadings; namely _____.

Affidavit Approved – The affiant has presented a viable pleading but is unable to pay the court filing fees in this action. The Clerk of Court shall accept and file the affiant’s pleadings without payment of filing fees, sheriff’s service fee, or any other required court costs until a final order/judgment is entered or the case is dismissed.

This order waiving filing fees is valid for thirty days. If no pleadings are filed within thirty days of this Order’s entry, affiant will need to re-apply for a waiver. Also, this Order waives filing fees for this civil action ***only*** and for no other.

Affidavit NOT Approved (not indigent) – The affiant has not demonstrated an inability to pay filing fees and associated costs of this action. Therefore, the affiant is not relieved from paying filing fees, sheriff’s service fee, or other required court costs.

Affidavit NOT Approved (no justiciable issue) – The pleading affiant seeks to file shows on its face such a complete absence of any justiciable issue of law or fact that it cannot be reasonably be believed that the Court could grant any relief against any party named in the pleading. The affiant’s request to file the pleading is hereby **DENIED**.
